a. (3) General: 2/35 Infantry maintained continued to conduct search and sweep, and unrelenting actions as a part of Task Force 1, the objective being portion of Operation 51. C-2/35, attached to 2/35 Artillery and a search front each of Company A and Company B, conducted patrols in support of 2/35 Infantry.

b. 2/35 Infantry conducted saturation patrolling in depth of the area of the former Locotol vicinity, 743603, to the area bounded by 740512 and 750415. Patrolling was conducted by two rifle platoons. The company continued improvement of the landing zone for future operations.

c. 2/35 conducted saturation patrolling in the immediate vicinity of the former Locotol vicinity, 743603, to the anti-force landing area west, five hundred meters to the east, seven hundred meters to the south, and one thousand meters to the west. All three rifle platoons were used in these patrols. The company continued improvement of the landing zone for future operations.

d. 2/35 Infantry continued saturation patrolling in the vicinity of the anti-force fire base, primarily directed to the east, platoon size patrols made. 741503 and 740503, northeast and to the outside of the anti-force base was reported at 743503 at 2015 hours, mortar fired upon positions to comfort the area, and a rifle platoon conducted a thorough sweep of the area; no significant or unusual activity was observed in vicinity of 740503 with no active result. The area contained local security and surveillance in a vicinity of the anti-force fire base, and continued improvement of the anti-force landing zone in preparation for subsequent operations.

e. C-2/9 Artillery continued support of all elements of the Task Force.

f. Several squads Platoon 2/35 Infantry maintained four refund positions astride the trail net running from north to south on the ridge line to the west of the fire base. These positions were held in order to fire upon any soldiers with whom contact. On closure with these fire bases the dismounted Platoon was advised to continue.

g. One squad Platoon 2/35 Infantry conducted support of the anti-force, and provided support to elements of 2/35 Infantry as required along their trail.

B, 4th Engineers confirmed improvement of the Task Force landing zone. Aircraft capacity reached four CH-46 helicopters by the end of the reporting period, and the efforts continued to enlarge the area and improve the approaches for subsequent traffic. Two D-4 bulldozers were lifted into the area at 1010 and 1045 hours and became operational by 1345, adding width and depth to the existing landing areas available for use. Fields of fire continued to be improved, and a tree mask preventing direct fire on the hillside to the west by C/2/3 Artillery was removed.

2. (c) Plans Summary

(C) (1) - (2) - (3)

a. A/2/35 will remain in present location vicinity Y4743603 until 0700H 30 March, when the company will move toward the present firebase located vicinity Y4742594 in a search and destroy operation to terminate at 071200H 4 March. The closure of 0700H 30 March will provide security for the Task Force Firebase, and A/2/35 will conduct saturation patrolling to a distance of 4,000 meters from the Z, within the area of operations during daylight hours, and saturating the logical routes of enemy movement in the vicinity of the firebase at night. On 09 March the company will displace from the current firebase to a new firebase located vicinity Y47435, replacing elements of the 2/3 Infantry on position; thereafter will conduct saturation patrolling in the vicinity of the new firebase as directed.

b. B/2/35 will remain at present location vicinity Y4741619 conducting night ambushes in the vicinity of the company base until 070700H March, when the company will begin a search and destroy operation to the southwest, covering the hill masses between the current location and the firebase to be occupied on 7 March, and terminating on or about 9 March. On closure the new firebase on 11 March, Company B will assume the functions of security of the new firebase.

c. C/2/35 will continue security of the Task Force firebase vicinity Y4742594, conducting night ambushes in the vicinity of the firebase during the night of 6-7 March, At 070700H March, Company C will begin a search and destroy operation to the southeast, covering the hill masses between the current location and the firebase to be occupied on 7 March, and terminating the operation on or about 14 March. On closure at the new firebase the company will rest and resupply for twenty-four hours, and will then be prepared to conduct search and destroy operations as directed.

d. The Reconnaissance Platoon 2/35 Infantry will remain attached to Company C until 070700 March, when it will revert to b-t. b-t control and provide security for the battalion firebase until the day it closes at 070700H March. On closure Company C, the Reconnaissance Platoon will be attached as a part of the firebase security element. On 9 March the Reconnaissance Platoon will secure the current firebase during the displacement to the new firebase, and will secure the firebase during the period of transition after all other elements have been moved to the new firebase. 8. (C) General: 2/35 Infantry strength is currently 88% present for duty vs authorized enlisted strength. Shortages are acute in MOS 11B, especially in E5 and E6 grades.

a. A/2/35 Infantry maintained task force firebase security vic Y1676535. Three squad size elements of Company A conducted saturation patrolling to the north, east, and west to vic Y1671551, Y1663526, and Y1702521. Company A continued improvement of the task force firebase.

b. B/2/35 Infantry departed their night location vic YA676582 at 100802H March and continued search and destroy operations to the southwest covering the hillmasses between their initial location and check point 12, vicinity YA676515.

c. C/2/35 moved from night loc vic YA694658 at midmorning after being resupplied and continued south linking up with the Radio Research Unit. Company C continued LZ improvement for resupply.

d. C/2/9 Artillery continued support of all elements of the task force.

e. Reconnaissance Platoon 2/35 (-) remains attached to Company A 2/35 Inf. One five man element remains at vic YA696560 as Radio Research Unit security.

f. Heavy Mortar Platoon 2/35 Inf. Continued support of the task force firebase, and provided support to elements of 2/8 Infantry on request.

g. Engineer squad, one from Company A, 4th Engineer continued LZ improvement.

h. Concept of Operations: During the period 10185 March the battalion will continue search and destroy operations on a general line YA6557 to YA6853 with two rifle companies. The company providing the security of the firebase, reinforced by the Reconnaissance Platoon, will also conduct saturation patrolling and night ambushes in vic Bn TF firebase.

7. (C) Psychological Operations: Leaflet drops directed against NVA targets have been requested in the area bounded by YA758600, YA770600, YA150580, and YA770580. This mission was requested on 4 March, planned for 5 March, but had not been conducted as of 101800H March 1967.

8. (C) General: 2/35 Inf strength is currently at 88% by present-for-duty vs. authorized enlisted strength. Shortages are acute in MOS 11B, especially in grades E5 and E6.

A. With the exception of Co C's finding of the still burning cooking fires, there have been no recent indications of the presence of large concentrations of the enemy West of the SE S^NM RJWP. There have been no incidents of aircraft receiving ground fire and no enemy contact.

B. The en continues to avoid contact. His large units are either in hiding in the area or they have pulled back across the border.
