SUMMARY: The 2-35th Inf continued Operation Malheur. Budhas Birthday truce was observed. A sweep and block of a village by Recon and C/3-4 (-) to provide protection for a NVN family moved futile. PFC Garner, Co C, was injured by a booby trap while his patrol was enroute to a night ambush. At 2400H, the truce ended and the numerous lights out of the perimeter were quickly extinguished.
