MISSION: B/2-35 Inf conducts "RANGER" type ambushes during daylight and darkness from 17 Oct until 20 Oct vicinity hill 464 (BS 728339) hill 484 (BS 729327) and trail junction vicinity BS 739330.

EXECUTION: (See Ops Overlay) Concept of operations, Phase I. B/2-35 prepares for "RANGER" type ambushes on 15 Oct by issuing orders, conducting inspections and rehearsals. B/2-35 departs LZ OD on foot at 160730 and moves to clandestine bivouac site VIC BS 7373347. B Co departs clandestine bivouac site NLT 170600 by platoons and moves to the vicinity of the respective ambush sites, hill 484, hill 464, and trail junction east of hill 484. B Co establishes a minimum of three day/night ambushes per platoon on trails at each ambush site. B Co remains in ambush until 151200. Phase II. B Co moves to clandestine bivouac sight at Sa Khoum, VIC BS 7355377. B Co departs clandestine bivouac site NLT 190600 and moves to the vicinity of their ambush sights located near hills 484 & 464 and remains in ambush until 201200 at which time B Co moves to and secures the extraction landing zone north of hill 464 (VIC BS 732347) for extraction by helicopter at 201400.

LRRP: Move with B/2-35 to the first clandestine bivouac site. Depart the clandestine bivouac NLT 170600 and move along route indicated to establish a secret OP VIC BS 707340. Observe the trails and report all activity in the area until 190600 at which time move along the route indicated to establish a secret OP at BS 687338. Maintain the OP in that vicinity until 201500 at which time move to and secure the extraction site at BS 687335, extract by helicopter at 201600.

At 120910 Oct 67, BS 730335, a seven man LRRP team was inserted with the mission of providing surveillance of the trail network in the area. The team leader was SSG Frost; two AN/PRC-25's were used for communications. The LRRP was inserted using two HU-1D helicopters and A Co secured the LZ. The insertion was completed without incident and the LRRP established communications with the BN CP at 120911 Oct. The LRRP moved with A Co as a cover to BS 737333 from where they split off at 121215 Oct. The team then moved west approximately 800 meters on the South side of hill 464 and established two observation posts at 121408 Oct, BS 730327, to scan the trail network in grid squares BS 7333, BS 7332, BS 7233, and BS 7232. They observed these areas for approximately four hours until the cloud ceiling lowered and visibility became severely limited. At 121910 Oct the LRRP sighted two V.C. carrying packs moving east on a magnetic azimuth of 99° on a trail at BS 732329. A Co was immediately notified that two V.C. were moving toward their ambush locations at BS 744324. At 130715 Oct the LRRP team started to move west to a new location and at 130800 they spotted five V.C. moving from the north to the south on an azimuth of 180° on a trail at BS 729328. Three of the V.C. were males and the other two were females. Four of the V.C. carried rifles (two long barrel rifles and two short barrel rifles). The five V.C. passed within 10 meters of the LRRP point man. The fifth V.C., a woman without a weapon, who passed the LRRP looked directly at the LRRP leader who was standing motionless. Whether the LRRP was observed was unknown but the five V.C. quickly disappeared into the brush. After this encounter, the LRRP team then moved south for approximately 100 meters and established two OP's at BS 729327. From this location they observed three V.C. with M-1 carbines at BS 724336. One of the V.C. was dressed in black P.J.'s while the other was dressed in black shorts. They were walking on a trail from the north to the south on a magnetic azimuth 160°. The LRRP leader requested artillery and the first round W.P. hit in the middle of the three enemy and the V.C. moved approximately twenty meters to their right into the bushes. The LRRP leader then adjusted the fire twenty meters left and requested H.E. The H.E. rounds hit directly in the bushes where the V.C. were hiding. The LRRP leader estimated that two V.C. were probably KIA and one V.C. was WIA. There was no movement in the bushes after the artillery was completed. At 131307 Oct the LRRP team observed three NVA wearing khaki uniforms, cartridge belts, and carrying M-1 rifles at BS 732338. They were moving north to south on a magnetic azimuth 175° on a trail east of hill 464. One of the NVA was wearing a pith helmet the other two were bareheaded. The three NVA stopped moving at BS 732338 and knelt down and looked in the direction of the LRRP O.P. One of the NVA pointed his weapon in the direction of the LRRP O.P. The LRRP leader requested artillery on the three NVA and the first rounds fell short in front of the enemy. The three NVA moved approximately four-hundred meters north-west up hill 464 when the second volley of artillery fire fell on top of hill 464. The three enemy continued moving north-west up hill until they disappeared over the

of the hill. During the artillery fire the LRRP leader observed a fourth A standing near the top of hill 464 at BS 728339. This NVA quickly disappeared after the second volley of artillery fire impacted. At 131327 Oct the LRRP leader requested that the LRRP team be extracted because he felt the three NVA had observed his position and knew that he was adjusting artillery fire in the area. The LRRP request for extraction was granted and at 131350 Oct the LRRP team was prepared for extraction. At 131421 Oct at BS 732328, the LRRP team was extracted by the C&C ship and one HU-1D with two gunships providing cover. The extraction was completed without incident.



1. On 151720 Oct, an eight man LRRP team was taken to LZ OP and placed under B Company's operational control and remained under B Company's control until 170700 Oct. The LRRP leader was SSG Frost and two AN/PRC-25 radios were used for communication.

2. The LRRP mission was to move with B Company on 16 Oct to a clandestine bivouac site at BS 73/347. They would spend the night at this location. At 170600 Oct the LRRP would move by a north-westerly route to an OP at BS 704344. At this OP they would observe the trail networks in the vicinity and would stay there until the morning of the 19th. On 190600 Oct, the LRRP team was to travel by a north-westerly route to a new O.P. at BS 68/377 and observe the trail systems in the area. They were to be extracted from a suitable PZ in this area on 201600 Oct.

3. At 161000 Oct, B Company with the LRRP moved from LZ OP to the clandestine bivouac site at BS 738348. They arrived at the site at 161830 Oct and remained there until the following morning. At 170605 Oct, the LRRP moved approximately eight-hundred meters northwest on an azimuth of 320° to hill 404 at BS 734353. At these coordinates, they found a lean-to which had been recently inhabited. At 160927 Oct, the LRRP then traveled south-west for about two-thousand meters on an azimuth of 195° to BS 728347. Along their route, they observed several freshly cut trails that ran generally from the west to the east (BS 717348 to BS 732351). The trees and rocks along the trails had signs painted on them with white paint as indicated (Δ-). The LRRP saw about five-hundred of these symbols. At steep crossings along these trails, the LRRP found hand rails to facilitate walking. At 161205 Oct, the LRRP moved one-hundred meters north on a azimuth of 360° to BS 728348. They discovered an recently used campsite with a small stream running from the east to the west. They found signs of previous campfires, rice scattered about the area, and three water troughs constructed of bamboo. There were large boulders in the area, forming several crevices and natural caves making concealed hiding places. At 161320 Oct, the LRRP heard voices coming from a draw a hundred meters to their east. They listened to the voices for ten minutes and were unable to determine the number of people. SSG Frost instructed the team to remain in their present position, while he and PFC Galindo investigated the voices. SSG Frost approached the suspicious area from the north and PFC Galindo moved into the area from the south. At 161320 Oct, SSG Frost sighted fourteen V.C. in a larger rocky area. Some were washing clothes and others were eating or preparing food. Three V.C. were approximately eight meters from SSG Frost's position. There were two males and one female wearing black P.J.'s. The two males were attempting to light a fire and the woman was pouring rice into a tin pot. The woman looked up and saw SSG Frost, he shot her and she fell backwards off the rock. The two men immediately reached for their SKS rifles but SSG Frost killed them with one burst of

automatic weapons fire. PFC Galindo, who was on the southside of the V.C. camp, observed two women coming down a trail headed south. He engaged these two and killed both of them. The remainder of the V.C. in the camp had taken refuge in the crevices and natural caves in the rocks. SSG Frost entered the campsite and began searching the area while PFC Galindo provided security. He found four sandbags of polished rice, one khaki uniform, several black P.J.'s, NVA shirts, cooking vessels, tobacco, and thirteen rounds of 7.62 ammunition. At 171420 Oct, the IRRP RTO had reported they were in contact and gunships were requested to engage the enemy camp. At 171430 Oct, SSG Frost and PFC Galindo had rejoined the team. They believed they had sufficiently broken contact and th-t extr-ct-ion was not necessary. The IRRP moved approximately two-hundred meters west on an azimuth of 270° to BS 726348 where they stopped to rest. At 171525 Oct, the IRRP medic observed two V.C. approaching from the east moving on a freshly cut trail vicinity BS 726348. He fired at both the V.C. and killed one. The other V.C. was engaged by the entire IRRP team and was killed. Both V.C. were wearing black shorts, one had on a grayish shirt and the other one wore an O.D. T-shirt. From the two dead V.C. the IRRP confiscated two NVA packs, one knife, two l-rge sickles, and one pistol belt.

#. At 171532 Oct, after this 1-st contact, the battalion S3 advised the IRRP they would be extracted from a PZ at BS 728346. The IRRP moved northwest two-hundred meters to the PZ and were extracted by two UH-1D helicopters with two gunships providing protection. The extraction was completed at 171552 Oct without incident.
