1. On 260745 Oct 67, a seven man LRRP under the operational control of Co D was combat assaulted into an LZ at BS 732342. The LRRP leader was SFC Frost and two AN/PNC-25 radios were used for communication.

2. The LRRP mission was to be inserted with Co D and detached from Co D shortly after touchdown. Once in position, the LRRP would contact Co B, who in turn would walk out to the area and conduct operations just north of the LRRP location. The LRRP would alert Co B of any enemy activity or movement towards Co B location.

3. The LRRP was detached from Co D at 260755 Oct 67, and moved 200 meters SE on an azimuth of 80 degrees. At 260826 Oct 67, the LRRP made a communications check with 2-35 IUC and reported their location at BS 735342. The LRRP moved to BS 735338 at 261134 Oct 67, and established two OP's having the mission to observe the trail network and open area in GS 7333. The LRRP remained at that location reporting negative observations. At 261800 Oct 67, the LRRP moved to a clandestine bivouac site located at BS 735340 for the night. The LRRP at 270700 Oct 67, reported their location as being BS 735338 and had established two OP's. Negative observations were reported until 271035 Oct 67. At this time, LRRP reported observing six VC at BS 732328 moving NW on an azimuth of 360 degrees. The six VC were wearing black pajamas, all were armed and two were carrying packs. At this time, the LRRP leader requested gunship support. At 271043 Oct 67, the VC were reported to be moving down the north slope of hill 484 and at that time were almost at the base of hill 484. It was reported by the LRRP leader that the VC concerned were at the bottom of hill 484, BS 732330 at 271047 Oct 67. At 271047 Oct 67, 3d Bde AVN aircraft were on station vicinity of the LRRP location. The LRRP leader directed the aircraft to a wooded area where the VC were last observed. The 3d Bde AVN aircraft fired into the area with unknown results. At this time the aircraft commander called for artillery to be fired into the suspected VC location. At 271215 Oct the LRRP leader assumed control and adjustment of the artillery fire. At 271300 Oct at BS 731331 the LRRP leader reported observing one VC KIA and one VC WIA from artillery fire. Again at 271441 Oct 67, the LRRP reported observing 2 VC at BS 742328, and artillery fire was requested. The LRRP leader requested extraction at 271516 Oct 67, because he felt his JP location had been compromised. The LRRP leader was instructed to remain at his present location until 29 Oct 67, at which time the LRRP would be extracted. At this time, LRRP reported observing six VC at DD 732338 moving NW on an azimuth of 360 degrees. The six VC were wearing black pajamas, all were armed and two were carrying pack. At this time, the LRRP leader requested gunship support. At 271043 Oct 67, the VC were reported to be moving down the north slope of hill A84, and at that time were almost at the base of hill A84. It was reported by the LRRP leader that the VC observed were at the bottom of hill A84, DD 732338 at 271047 Oct 67. 271047 Oct 67, 3d Bde AVN aircraft were on station vicinity of the LRRP location. The LRRP leader directed the aircraft to a wooded area where the VC were last observed. The 3d Bde AVN aircraft fired into the area with unknown results. At this time the aircraft commander called for artillery to be fired into the suspected VC location. At 271215 Oct the LRRP leader assumed control and adjustment of the artillery fire. At 271300 Oct at DD 731331 the LRRP leader reported observing one VC KIA and one VC WIA from artillery fire. Again at 271441 Oct 67, the LRRP reported observing 2 VC at DD 742338, and artillery fire was requested. The LRRP leader requested extraction at 271516 Oct 67, because he felt his OP location had been compromised. The LRRP leader was instructed to remain at his present location until 29 Oct 67, at which time the LRRP would be extracted. At 271755 Oct 67, the LRRP leader again requested extraction of his element due to a personal problem with his men. Permission was granted by CO, 2-35 Inf.


