1. On 310608 Oct a 6 man LRP was inserted under the cover of darkness at cord. BS590528. The LRP leader was SSG Frost and two AN/FRT-25 radios were used for communication.

2. The LRP mission was to move to a concealed position from where they could observe all activity in the vicinity of BS 6051 which was the area selected for the 2-35 Bn base camp in the forthcoming operation "SHORT TIME".

3. As soon as the LRP was in position it started reporting heavy activity in the area as follows:

- 310930 LRRP reported to be in position at cord. BS 592526 and observing 3 VC, 2 in Black PJ's and 1 in Khakis with a weapon moving west from Tan Phu 1.
- 310945 4 VC dressed in Black PJ's and 2 NVA in green uniforms move to hole LOC at BS 596515 and pickup 5 weapons and one pack. LRRP heard 2 shots fired, they believe them to be a signal to assemble.
- 310950 1 VC from group of 6 moving West on trail at LOC BS 602522.
- 311146 1 VC observed moving west to west on trail at cord. BS 602522. Another at BS 607521. The two met and talked about 4 min. No weapons. 1 VC observed at 597515, another at 618533. 3 VC came out of hole at 597515.
- 311450 2 VC observed cooking beside hole at BS 597515. 1 man went in a hole and a few minutes later two came out.
- 311450 5 VC observed in vic. of hole all in Black PJ.
- 311530 2 VC, 1 in Black PJ and one in gray uniform with packs came out of hut cord. BS 596515 and move East.
- 311540 2 VC moving from VAN XUAN west to hwy 516. They hid in bushes when a helicopter flew over.
- 1620 Observed 1 Female come out of large hole and met a VC dressed in a tan uniform. VC male entered a hole. Woman went to a cooking area approx. 50 meters from hole. Vic. cord. 601518.

SUBJCT: LRRP After Action Report

12 Nov 67

1622 Observed 2 VC. 1 in gray and 1 in black with a pack on trail. Vicinity BS 595515.

1630 Observed 2 VC in black with weapons on same trail as just mentioned, with a man trailing behind them approximately 50-75 meters. All moved to a large haystack and went out of sight.

~~CONFIDENTIAL~~

1635 Observed 2 VC in black moving South towards Tan Phu (3) cord. BS 616528. Last sight of them was a village. At 1640 observed 1 of the men near family bunker in same village.

1640 Observed 4 men digging at BS 597514. 3 wearing black S. 1 in gray, could not identify what they were digging.

1700 Walked on south side of village. Observed 3 VC in black and 1 had a pack.

1705 Observed 2 more VC in black with weapons and packs all moving north.

1710 (A) 8 men came from Van Kinh and started to cut rice at BS 613534. (B) 8 others were observed at BS 518606. They were talking and then they split into 2 four man groups. One group went to Long Binh 1 and the other to Tan Phu 1. (C) Observed 12 VC moving west at BS 612502 and they went to Nhon. Location BS 612502.

2000 Observed campfires at Long Binh 1, Phu Tho, BS 627508 and 635555.

2025 Reported all fires have gone out except two. One is about 100 meters from base of hill, vicinity BS 591526. The other is on hill 507.

2035 Reported the fire on hill 507 is much brighter.

2207 LRRP reported to have movement 15 meters to their rear.

2211 LRRP reported whatever it was passed. No movement was observed until 010645 when LRRP reported 4 VC in black enter large hole near haystack, vicinity BS 595515. One came out wearing a gray uniform.

010730 We observed 1 VC moving from Tan Phu 1 to a hole, vicinity BS 614527. A few minutes later 4 VC came out of the hole.

0740 Observed 1 more VC come out of same hole and was dressed in gray, cord. BS 519555.

SUBJECT: LARP After Action Report

1- Nov 67

- 0745 Observed 3 more come from a hole and have what appears to be tools, a large pack, and a large pole 5 to 6 ft. long, which is silver in color.
- 0750 Observed 6 more VC leave a hole and go to a ditch 50 meters away.
- 0755 Observed 3 more silver poles taken from the hole and 1 VC wrapping up a large pack. Observed a man in gray uniform with a weapon and pack approach the hole from the north and into the hole.
- 1045 Observed 4 VC leave Long Binh 1 and move to Tan Phu 1. They walked in a single file with a minute interval between each man.
- 1100 Observed 1 VC leave Long Binh and move to Tan Phu 2 and another followed at 1105. Both VC enter Tan Phu 1 a certain way. They do not take the main trail. It is a possibility the area could be mined.
- 1145 Observed 1 VC go to Tan Phu 2 from Long Binh 1.
- 1235-1250 Observed 6 VC, one with a weapon, in vicinity of BS 622537.
- 1303 Observed 1 VC enter a camouflaged hut at cord. BS 625535.
- 1330 Observed 3 VC move from Van Xuan to Ban Thoi. One more followed at 1332.
- 1340 Observed 3 VC (Female) at south end of Tan Phu 1 carrying something on their backs.
- 1350 Observed 3 VC with packs moving east on a trail at PT 155315.
- 1420 Observed 2 VC with packs and weapons moving south to Tan Phu 1. Observed 4 VC with weapons moving from Long Binh to Tan Phu.
- 1430 Observed 2 VC, both with weapons, and one with a pack moving to Tan Phu 1. VC came from the south.
- 1435 Observed 13 VC moving north on Hwy 516. They came from Tan Phu (3). 5 in gray, 8 in black, and all had weapons and packs. Cord. BS 611330.
- 1442 Observed 2 VC with weapons and packs enter Long Binh 2 from the south. They met 10 others who also had weapons and packs. They continued to move north and walked in single file with a 10 to 15 meter interval between each man.

SUBJECT: LRRP after action Report

12 Nov 67

- 1840 The same group which was observed at 1305, picked up 3 more men and were still moving north on Hwy 516. One of the men appeared to be carrying a mortar.
- 1856 Reported pulling in LP's as it was too dark to see.
- ~~CONFIDENTIAL~~ Reported observing five again on hill 507 at the same time as observed last night.
- 020207 Observed to the north what appears to be a flare going on and off.
- 020315 The flare turned out to be a flashlight carried by a VC, he passed within 30 meters of our position, wearing black BD, had a weapon and was moving south toward Long Binh 1.
- 020359 Observed the same VC in a village at, BS 614517.
- 020647 Observed 5 VC approximately 15 meters from our position.
- 021110 Reported that we had received one incoming hand grenade. The visibility was poor but estimate that the grenade came from approximately 35 meters to the north of our location.
- 021110 LRRP was advised to change their location.
- 021200 LRRP location BS 594524.
- 021213 LRRP located at BS 598525.
- 021219 LRRP requested extraction but were instructed to find some concealment and continue their mission.
- 021317 LRRP requested again to be extracted as they believed their position to be compromised and there was no other area which offered good concealment.
4. The LRRP was extracted at 021403 from BS 603524 without incident.


