At this time we called a dust off. At this time I returned to my NL.

I questioned members of the squad that these two EM came from. These two EM one of them had been told by myself to take two EM from his squad. The EM was told to take this EM to check NW of his gun position. At approx -30 mts from his gun position he was to check out AO for traps. At this time the only thing that I can think of that happened is that the two EM went in the wrong direction. They were also 100 meters from the NL.
